**Unit of Study:** Woodland & Forest Animals

**Bible Story:** The Transfiguration

**Big Idea:** Jesus is Holy!

**Sharetime:** Children may bring one item from home that reminds them of woodland or forest animals!

**Home Enrichment Activities:**



- Take a family trip to El Dorado Nature Center. Take a walk along one of the paths and see if you and your child can spot any animals that might live in the forest! Stop by the Visitor's Center to explore and learn more about animals that live in woods and forests!
- Create your own indoor forest with your child. Have them help you choose some of their stuffed animals to represent the kinds of animals that might live in the forest, or color several forest-animal coloring pages with your child. Set up the stuffed animals or coloring sheets all around your living room. Tape two toilet paper rolls together for "binoculars" and go exploring in your forest!
- Help your child come up with a list of ways Jesus is special. Help them remember that Jesus is special because He is God's Son, He made the world, He can heal us, etc. Remind them that Jesus is holy (and that means he is set apart and different)!
