Unit of Study: Me! My Emotions!

Bible Story: The Garden of Eden

Big Idea: God takes care of us!

Sharetime: Students may bring in one item from home that makes them feel happy!

Home Enrichment Activities:

- Use your child's stuffed animals/dolls to engage them in role-playing. Start by using the toy to act out emotions, with your child responding to you. See how your child responds to "Teddy" being mad or "Puppy" being sad. Then switch roles, with your child acting out the emotions through the toy. Use this time to show your child examples of appropriate ways to respond to their own emotions as well as the emotions of others.
- Take time to label your child's emotions this week and help them think about why they are feeling the way they are. (Example: "What a big smile! You are so happy!") There is huge value in this, as it will help your child understand that everyone feels different things at different times.
- This week we're talking about the Garden of Eden during Bible time. Genesis 2:8-9 says, "Then the Lord God planted a garden in Eden in the east, and there he placed the man he had made. The Lord God made all sorts of trees grow up from the ground—trees that were beautiful and that produced delicious fruit. In the middle of the garden he placed the tree of life and the tree of the knowledge of good and evil." Read this passage to your child and ask them what other kinds of plants they think God might have put in the Garden of Eden. Then, take a trip to the garden center to check out some of the different plants God made for us to enjoy!
