Home Enrichment Activities:

- Choose a book that has pictures of humans in it to read with your child. After going through the book once, look through the pictures and ask your child to point to different body parts they see in the book and compare them to their own. (Ex: Where are Jimmy's ears? Where are your ears?)
- Go outside and engage your child in different activities that involve moving their whole body. (Ex: Running, jumping, spinning) Make sure to do it with them! ☺ After each activity, ask your child which parts of their body they used.
- Each of us is created in the image of God. Psalm 139:13-16 tells us that God created us and knows us inside and out! It also tells us that we are "fearfully and wonderfully made" and before we were even born, God knew all about us! Tell your child some things that you appreciate about him/her. (Ex: You are so helpful/kind/thoughtful....etc.) Help them see that God has given them those gifts and remind them that they are fearfully and wonderfully made by God!

Welcome Letter: Every student has a welcome letter in their cubby that explains important information about what our students participate in throughout the year. The "Welcome Letter" also informs you which day is your child's share day.

Reminder: This is a reminder that all shoes need to be closed toed and closed heeled. Please refer to your school handbook for more information. Also, please remember to label all your child's items that they bring to school, such as lunch, hat, share items, etc.
