Unit of Study: Christmas Stars, Christmas Wreaths

Week's Work: Students will discuss Christmas Wreaths and Christmas Stars. We will learn the

proper printing and sound for the letter "M". We will be making a list of words that

rhyme with the word "mad", such as "rad" and "sad".
